All photos must be named with category, nominee, project and number in series. Example: commercial\_renowned\_architects\_harbor\_pub\_01. These images are used in the production of the Wood Design Awards evening program for Monday, March 14, 2011.

## IMPORTANT NOTES

- 1) All nomination packages should clearly indicate all the necessary contact information for both the nominator and the nominee (primary contact name, phone number, mailing address).
- 2) Once a nomination is submitted, it becomes the property of Wood *WORKS!* Wood *WORKS!* reserves the right to use submitted materials for future promotional use. Nomination packages will not be returned to the nominees or the submitting party.
- 3) Multiple submissions are allowed, but they should not be grouped together. Multiple submissions should be easily separated into the specific award groupings.
