Structural Engineering Position

The Canadian Wood Council, the national association representing Canadian manufacturers of wood products used in construction is seeking a highly motivated and skilled individual to advance the use of wood products as a state-of-the-art building material.

The candidate will be responsible for strategic building code and standards initiatives; applied engineering problem-solving; developing new design tools and publications; and delivery of end products through seminars and media to targeted audiences, including engineers, architects, building officials and contractors.

The ideal candidate will be a registered engineer with experience in the structural design of wood structures and an understanding of building science principles. Consideration will also be given to graduate engineers who will be eligible for professional registration.

In addition, the candidate should have strong written and oral communication skills and the ability to work in an English and French environment. An understanding of wood products and the wood products industry is desirable. Ability to travel within North America will be required.
